



Club Championship 2015

Match Modus

U6: Red Ball – mini courts (best of 3 tie-break sets – 7/7 golden point)

U8: Orange Ball – full court (best of 3 sets to 4, tie-break at 4/4, 2 points difference)

U10: Green ball – full court (best of 3 sets to 4, tie-break at 4/4, 2 points difference)

U12: full court (best of 3 sets to 4, tie-break at 4/4, 2 points difference)

U14, U16, U18, *Teenager event: Best of 3 sets to 6 or super tie-break in the 3rd set if agreed before the match.

Seniors: Pro team event, Ladies's Singles, Men's Singles, Ladies' Doubles, Men's Doubles, Mixed Doubles: Best of 3 sets to 6 or super tie-break in the 3rd set if agreed before the match

Ladies' +35, +45, +55 and +65 & Men's +35, +45, +55 and +65: Compulsory super tie-break in 3rd set.

Rusty Rackets: 1 set to 6

***Newbies Event:** 1 set to 6

***Family Doubles:** 1 set to 6

Rules

Every match should be played following the time schedule (limited exceptions can be made in agreement with both players and the organiser of the Club Championships).

If a player is more than 15 minutes late to the agreed time of the match, this will result in the opponent automatically receiving a bye.

Alterations of playing date/time have to be made with the agreement of the opponent and organiser of the Club Championships.

The management will set an ultimate date if the players can't come to an agreement.

Maximum inscriptions is 4 disciplines. Under 13 years of age can enter ladies 'or men's doubles, but must play with an adult partner.
